Video

- Outline one element of the programme that excites you, and why you would like to join Team Communicate.
- Don't worry about the quality of the video, or how you record it, we're not looking for the next Spielberg!

Questions

Tell us why you are applying to Team Communicate in less than 200 words:

Examples:

- Have you participated in NHC activities through volunteering and would like to take on more responsibility?
- Do you have interest in the wildlife sector, but you've not known where to start?
- Have you volunteered before?
- Have you struggled to find flexible volunteer/training opportunities previously?

What would you hope to get out of Team Communicate in less than 200 words:

Examples:

- You would like event production experience
- You would like to meet like-minded people and network
- You would like to develop new skills
- You would like to take part in more events in Bristol/Bath

What skills do you have and/or would like to develop through Team Communicate in less than 100 words:

Examples:

Filming, writing, biological recording, public engagement, social media, grant writing, finance, volunteer management, art and design, production, media experience, office administration, website design...
